DECLARING OR CHANGING A GRADUATE CONCENTRATION (MASTER'S DEGREE ONLY)

Selected graduate (master's and doctoral) degree programs require students to complete a concentration toward degree completion. A graduate concentration requires a minimum of fifteen (15) quarter hours of graduate-level coursework. Students may choose from any of the approved concentrations for the degree program in which they are enrolled. Completion of such a concentration will appear on students' official academic record, e.g., official transcript.

A student who did not declare a concentration at the time of application for admission must complete this form to do so in consultation with her/his Academic Advisor. *Students in the Ed.D. program must contact the program for instructions on how to declare or change her/his concentration.*
